- At 5 p.m. on Monday and Friday at the Lua Theater there will be a presentation of security measures and the crew
- At 6 p.m. on Monday and Friday the boat sets sail and the welcome cocktail awaits you on the Sol terrace.
- Be at the Lua Theater 10 minutes before departure to the expeditions for preparation.
- For riding and visiting expeditions, we suggest the use of light clothing, flip-flops or sneakers, raincoat, sunscreen, sunglasses, hat or cap, water, camera or cell phone.
- For jungle expeditions, we suggest the use of long pants, light long-sleeved shirts, sneakers or boots, socks, raincoat, insect repellent, sun block, hat or cap, sunglasses, water and camera or cell phone.

- It is not allowed to carry alcoholic beverages or smoke during expeditions.
